

Curriculum Feedback Analysis & Action Taken Report (Year: 2023-24)

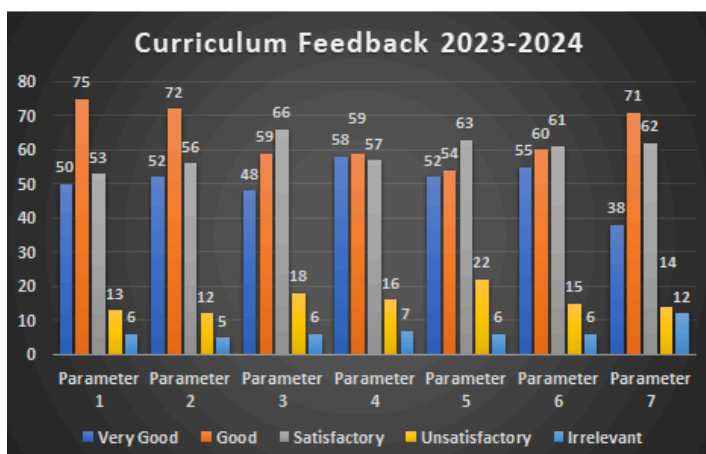
Students Feedback

Feedback on curriculum was collected from students in the following areas:

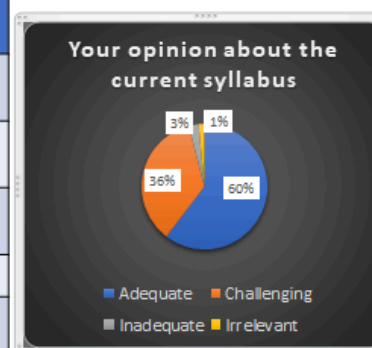
1. Knowledge and Concept
2. Analytical Abilities and Skill
3. Employability
4. Coverage of course through practical

A total of 197 Students gave feedback on curriculum. 60% of students said syllabus is adequate and 36% challenging. In general 36% rated the syllabus good, 20% as very good and 31% rated as satisfactory.

Students feedback suggestions: Topics are very interesting though the syllabus is vast.

Alumni Feedback

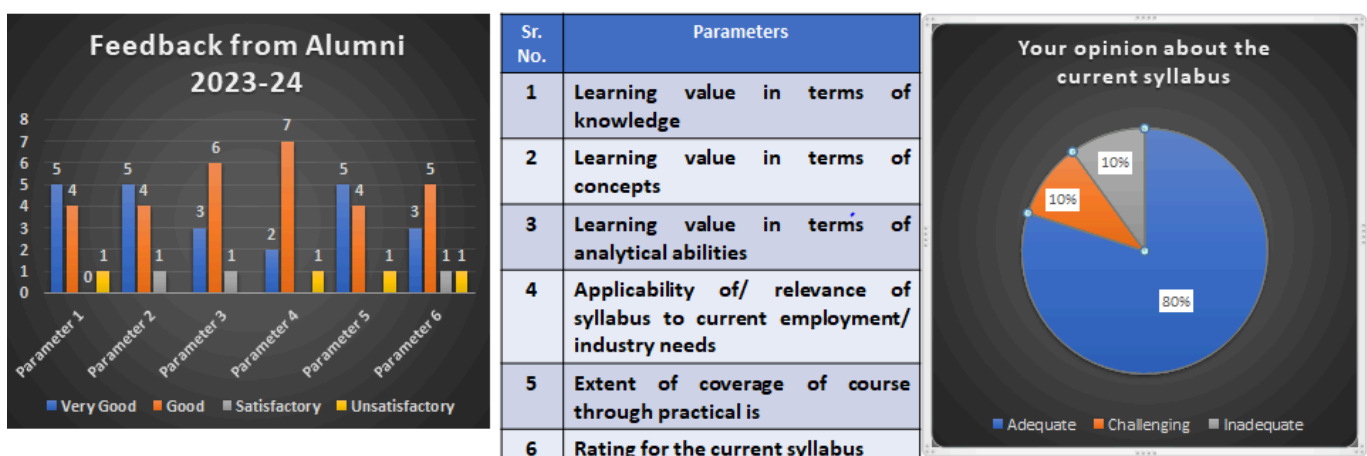
Feedback on curriculum was collected from Alumni in the following areas:

3. Employability
4. Coverage of course through practical

80% of the alumni said the curriculum is adequate and 10% said it's challenging and 10% said syllabus is inadequate. Most Alumni have given very good or good ratings for the syllabus in terms of industrial applicability, analytical abilities, and learning values.

Most of the alumni rated the syllabus as 'good' in terms of applicability or relevance of the syllabus and its practical approach.

Alumni suggestions: The syllabus covers all the important topics needed. No change needed in the syllabus.



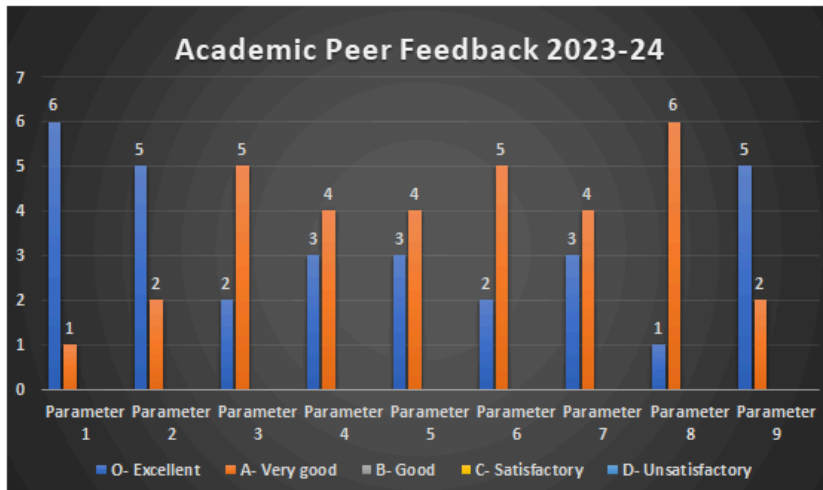
Academic Peer Feedback

Feedback on curriculum was collected from Peer in the following areas:

Peers appreciated the syllabus of both theory and practical. Over all 71% of peers rated the syllabus excellent and 29% very good. For all other 7 parameters the response was good or very good. Overall the course content offered is excellent.

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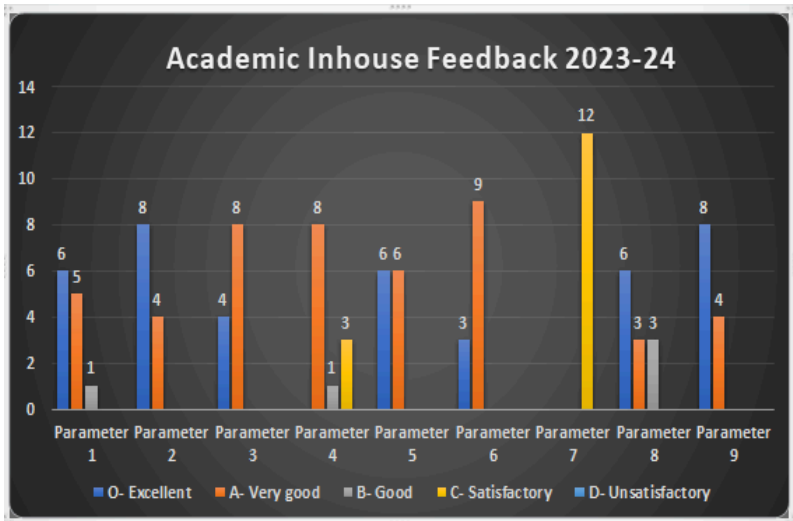
