
ANNUAL QUALITY REPORT (2019-2020)

Ramnarain Ruia College (now autonomous), was established in 1937 by the Shikshana Prasaraka Mandali, Pune and is one of the pioneering institutions for higher education in Mumbai. Our Autonomous status (2017) has brought us greater freedom to design innovative, skill-based courses. Our Logo, 'Explore–Experience–Excel', sums up our quest for excellence.

The College offers core courses in Arts and Science with 13 subjects for Arts and 13 subjects for Science including vocational courses. It also offers 13 PhD programs (04 in Arts and 09 in Science) with student strength of ~3100 (UG~2500, PG~600).




Enrolment in BA & BMM






Enrollment in B.Sc. & M.Sc. Bioanalytical Science




Enrollment in M.Sc. Chemistry



Enrolled Intake Capacity


Enrollment in M.Sc. Life Science, Botany, Biochemistry, Biotechnology








Enrollment in M.Sc. Zoology, Physics, Microbiology, Information technology, Computer Science

Curriculum Enrichment:


All PG departments have introduced internships either in the 3rd or 4th semester.
