





Trends in Student Enrolment:




Enrolment in BA & BACM

Enrolment in B.Sc. (Aided), Computer Science, Biotechnology & Biochemistry






Enrolment in B.Sc. & M.Sc. Bioanalytical Sciences




Enrolment in M.Sc. Chemistry




Enrolled Intake Capacity


